**Joint Request for Extension of Time to File Revised HPMP**

Dear Secretary Bose:

On January 22, 2019, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) staff issued a letter to The Nevada Hydro Company, Inc. (“Nevada Hydro”) requesting that Nevada Hydro submit a revised Historic Properties Management Plan (“HPMP”) for the above referenced project by June 30, 2019 (“January 22 Letter”). Among other things, the January 22 Letter requested that Nevada Hydro address comments of the Pechanga Band of Luiseño Indians (the “Tribe”), a federally recognized Indian tribe and sovereign government.

On April 30, 2019, the Tribe filed a letter requesting that Commission staff extend the deadline for Nevada Hydro to file its revised HPMP until August 15, 2019, to allow the Tribe sufficient time to prepare and provide Nevada Hydro comments on the plan, which will address a large number of historic properties the Tribe has identified within the area of potential effects (“APE”). On May 13, 2019, Commission staff granted the request, allowing Nevada Hydro to submit the revised HPMP by August 15, 2019.

On August 2, 2019, Nevada Hydro and the Tribe jointly filed a request for an additional 60-day extension of time to submit the revised HPMP. On August 21, 2019, Commission staff again granted the request, allowing Nevada Hydro to submit the revised HPMP by October 14, 2019.

Although the parties have been working diligently, an additional extension is necessary to allow the Tribe additional time to provide Nevada Hydro with comments on the HPMP. Accordingly, Nevada Hydro and the Tribe hereby request an additional 30-day extension of time to submit the revised HPMP.
